Tennessee Scholastic Action Shooting Program Championship Held at the Carroll County Shooting Sports Complex

The Carroll County Shooting Sports Complex, the largest Scholastic Action Shooting Program (SASP) range in the country, hosted the 2017 SASP state championship. Youth from Illinois, Indiana, Missouri and Wisconsin also participated, but were eligible for national placement only. In total, there were 350 shooters.

Governed nationally by the Scholastic Shooting Sports Foundation and administered in the state by Tennessee Wildlife Resources Foundation, the SASP uses shooting sports to teach sportsmanship, responsibility, honesty, ethics, teamwork and other life skills.
